The week of September 5th the home will sponsor a musical fest, there will be 5 different entertainers performing; one for each day; VOLUNTEERS NEEDED. The kitchen at Boland Hall is being remolded and when it is finished the meals for the residents will be cooked on sight and will no longer be shipped from King Veterans Home.
